Excerpts-Latest update from Cardinal Collins

His Eminence Cardinal Collins has issued an update on June 7, 2021 for the entire Archdiocese as the Province announced revisions to the "Roadmap for Reopening" as they relate to places of worship. The updated measures in places of worship opening at 15% capacity in Step 1 and 25% capacity in Step 2.

Step 1 of the provincial reopening plan will begin on Friday, June 11 (Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus). Parishes must continue to implement our WorshipSafe Health and Safety protocols.

June 15 Professor Patricia Murphy St. Augustine's Seminary in Toronto **Courage in Difficult Times**

Dr. Patricia Murphy is a graduate of the Christianity and Culture Program at the University of St. Michael's College in Toronto. Thank you for all that you are doing for ShareLife! This message concerns changes to collection dates for our current ShareLife campaign.

When we announced the collection dates for 2021, we did so on the basis that our parishes would be open. As of last week, it was uncertain if we would be back in our parishes when the second ShareLife collection was to take place (June 19-20).

The recent announcement that we will be able to celebrate Mass, starting this weekend, with 15% capacity, is a welcome and positive sign that we are moving forward. At this time, we recognize that reopening of parishes there will be many priorities for pastors and parish communities to address in the next few weeks. Given this, with the Episcopal Board and the Chair of the ShareLife Advisory Board, we will be changing the second and third collection dates for ShareLife as follows:

ShareLife 2nd collection-the weekend of October 2-3, 2021 (this was the originally scheduled 3rd collection date). ShareLife 3rd collection-the weekend of October 30-31, 2021.

Our agencies and the people they serve have been severely affected by the pandemic. We thank you for all that you are doing for ShareLife, and for your understanding as we make these necessary adjustments to the 2021 ShareLife collection dates.
