## **Excerpts-Latest update from Cardinal Collins**

His Eminence Cardinal Collins has issued an update on July 12, 2021 for the entire Archdiocese as the Province announced revisions to the "Roadmap for Reopening" as they relate to places of worship. The updated measures in Step 3.

In Step 3, there is no capacity limit for places of worship. Physical distancing of 2 metres (6ft) is still required between parishioners attending Mass who are not from the same household. Due to the physical distancing requirement, most churches will not realize any significant increase in capacity.
