# The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus June 11, 2021 The Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary, June 12, 2021



This year celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart is on Friday June 11. Every year it is on the Friday following the second Sunday after Pentecost.

And the day after, on Saturday June 12, we commemorate The Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

When we hear the name, "Most Sacred Heart of Jesus," most of us probably think of a statue that appears in many of our churches: the image where Jesus stands with his heart, burning with joy and love for us, exposed to all. In a reflection on the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus Pope Francis said, "It is more difficult to let God love us than to love Him! The best way to love Him in return is to open our hearts and let Him love us." Every time we see these statues, we are reminded to open ourselves to the love of Christ and give ourselves completely to him as he does. He lays his heart open before us as an example of how to live our lives.

We read in the gospel of Matthew:

Come to me, all you who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." (Matthew 11:28-29)

Let us receive the abundant blessing from our Lord through the intercession of the Virgin Mary

On <u>Friday June 11,</u> on the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at Guardian Angels from <u>10:00 am to 1:00 pm.</u>

1st Reading: Exodus 24.3-8 2nd Reading: Hebrews 9.11-15

Gospel: Mark 14.12-16, 22-26 – *The Last Supper* 

Summary

Jesus' death on the cross is what defeated Satan and opened wide the gates of Heaven so that we who seek to follow Him can enter into that eternal rest. St. Thomas Aquinas says that "the celebration of Holy Mass is as valuable as the death of Jesus on the cross." Therefore, we as stewards should run to Mass as often as we can because Jesus is waiting to pour out the same love, mercy and grace that he showed on the cross.
